THE SBIR & STTR PROGRAMS

The SBIR & STTR programs provide over \$2.5 billion annually to small businesses from 11 Federal agencies. SBIR & STTR focus on innovative new ideas (many technology based) that can be converted into new products and services. Some agencies, like the Dept of Defense and NASA, fund projects for their own internal use. Other agencies, like NIH, NSF and USDA, fund projects where the ultimate customer is someone else.
